Students Feedback Analysis

In the current year based on the findings, this report has been prepared. A summary is given below:

- Majority of the students were of the opinion that the course content of the programme, subject knowledge of teachers were found to be excellent.
- They go to the library regularly and avail the benefits.
- They have been aware of the existence of different associations and clubs in the college to enhance their qualities and standards.
- 73% of the students have an impression that the teachers were excellent in their communication skill, punctuality and regularity.
- The students remarked that the teachers were always supportive in co-curricular activities and maintain a good relationship with them.
- Most of the students showed their interest in NCC and other extension services.
- 64% of students have an opinion that the administrative and library staff are very supportive.

The analysis reflects the students' satisfaction level in the above parameters on the basis of which the IQAC suggests reforms and innovations in teaching learning, other facilities and support system for a student-centered educative atmosphere in the College.

Alumni Feedback Analysis

The feedback from our alumni is valuable for us as it provides us the inputs regarding improvement in academic facilities and employability of our students. We appeal our alumni to provide there sincere feedback to us though mails and google forms. This time we have received feedback from total 30 alumni.

The feedback report shows that

- 18% alumni feel that the curriculum designed by the university is good and require no change.
- 29% of alumni feel that there is need to add more practical approach in the curriculum.
- 5% alumni feel that there is need to add extracurricular activities and activities related to
 placements in the curricular.
- 13% of them feel that there is need to add latest technology in the syllabus.
- 34% students did not comment anything on the curriculum.

Faculty Feedback Analysis:

The faculty of the college are backbone of the college. There feedback matters a lot for the improvement of the college.

- 99% of the faculty are of the opinion that Current CBCS syllabus is need based.
- 66% agree to the fact that Curriculum is as per the industry requirement and job suffice.
- 82% say that Programmes outcomes of the syllabi is well defined.
- 50% agrees to the fact the course content fulfills the employability skills of the students.
- 50% says there is the need of review of the current syllabus.
- 73% of the faculty says that curriculum helps them in enhancing their skills.
- 50% says that the college has given them full freedom to adopt new techniques / strategies
 of teaching such as group discussions, seminar presentations and learners' participation.
- 82% agrees to the fact that they get freedom to adopt new techniques / strategies of testing and assessment of students.
- More than 50% faculty members are satisfied with the library facilities and feel that the atmosphere of the college is good for teaching and learning.
- They are of the opinion that the college provides adequate opportunities and support to faculty members for upgrading their skills and qualifications.
- ICT facilities in the college are adequate and satisfactory.
- Majority of them say that the environment in the College is conducive to teaching and research
